



2010-2011 Uniform Code

The fall/spring uniform is worn from September until Columbus Day, and again after the spring vacation until the end of the school year. Students wear the winter uniform during the rest of the academic year.

For **class trips** and **out-of-uniform days**, students should wear nice looking pants, dresses, skirts, or shorts. Students are not permitted to wear tank tops, tee-shirts with inappropriate sayings, or reveal their midriff. On some occasions blue jeans will not be permitted.

Students should be mindful of their dress at **school dances**. Students will receive guidelines on this at school. Students might be denied entry to such events if their dress is considered inappropriate and not in keeping with the discussed guidelines.

As with all aspects of the Holy Child program, the goal of the school uniform is to help promote a non-competitive, comfortable, and cohesive environment and one that is conducive to learning.

When ordering by phone, please identify your daughter as a student at School of the Holy Child, Rye in order to receive the proper uniform skirt. You will be asked for specific measurements.

When ordering, please specify that you are ordering through the School Uniform Program. **Our "Preferred School Number" is 9000-3152-7 and must be used for all orders.** If you choose to have the Holy Child script logo on an article of clothing, our logo number is 9839332 K.

Skirts – All school skirts should be ordered through Flynn & O'Hara.

Sweaters – All blue school sweaters (monogram optional) should be ordered through Flynn & O'Hara or Lands' End School Uniform Program. Our Lands' End sweater is the blue crewneck cotton Drifter sweater.

Shirts – Shirts may be purchased anywhere, as long as they meet the School's uniform requirements. Please note that both Flynn & O'Hara and Lands' End carry appropriate shirts.

Pants, shoes/sneakers, socks, tights – These items may be purchased anywhere, as long as they meet the uniform requirements.

Gym uniform (including school sweatshirt) –These items may be ordered through the Holy Child Physical Education Department.

Final Notes

Extremes in fashion are not allowed. Students may not wear excessive jewelry to school. Nose rings and other facial piercings are not permitted. Jewelry and make-up should be kept to a modest minimum. "Extremes" include tattoos which should remain covered during school activities.

For class trips, retreat days, mixers, one-act plays and other days designated as out-of-uniform, clothing must be tasteful and in good condition. Clothing options are limited to:

Dresses

Skirts

Dressy shorts

Slacks

Dress tee-shirts

Polo shirts or blouses

Students are not permitted to wear halter-tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, short shorts, or cropped tops. No tee-shirts with inappropriate language, ripped jeans, bare shoulders or midriffs, spandex, or lycra.
